Instructions

Step 1 - Safety

- Unload the weapon
- Physically and visually inspect the chamber, bore, and magazine to ensure that all ammunition has been removed.
- Store ammunition in an area that is separate from your training area.
- It is recommended to lightly lubricate the adapter's o-ring before use.

▲ WARNING: Failure to follow safety instructions may result in injury or death.

Step 2 - Installation

- 1 Unscrew the laser cartridge and insert the battery pack according to the picture (flat side facing up). Reassemble the laser cartridge carefully. Verify the threading is fully closed and that there is no gap.
- 2 Open the Shotgun Adapter by unscrewing the adapter cap. Insert the cartridge into the body of the adapter and reassemble the adapter by screwing the cap back on and tightening gently.
- 3 Open the chamber of the shotgun, insert the Shotgun adapter as you would insert a single cartridge.
- Using your finger or the back end of a pencil, rotate the adapter and align the grooves on the adapter's cap to be positioned in the chamber so that the weapon's extractor will NOT come in contact with the adapter while cycling.

Step 3 - Removal

- 4 Open the chamber.
- 5 Using your finger or the back end of a pencil, rotate the Shotgun Adapter by pushing the grooves on the adapter's cap until it is aligned in the chamber so that the weapon's extractor WILL come in contact with the adapter's rim.
- Cycle the weapon over a soft surface to eject the adapter.
- Remove the Laser Bullet from the adapter.
- Remove the battery from the laser cartridge when not in use.
